INTRODUCTION

Welcome to HMAS Cerberus. This guide provides you with important information to assist you whilst you visit the RAN's largest training establishment.

VISITOR RESPONSIBILITIES

Safety requires your cooperation. For this reason **all** visitors shall:

- Obey all safety directions given by a Defence employee;
- Ensure the adequate supervision of accompanying children;
- Immediately report any hazard or hazardous condition to a Defence employee;
- Report all accidents/incidents to a Defence employee
- Not enter any restricted/designated area without authorisation;
- Not bring into or consume alcohol/illegal drugs at a Defence workplace;
- Not wilfully or recklessly interfere with any Defence property.

FIRE/EMERGENCY/FIRST AID

All fire/emergency incidents must be reported immediately to a Defence employee. If emergency assistance is required, the contact details below are to be utilised. In the event that evacuation is required, follow the directions of Defence staff and proceed immediately to the nearest fire exit and vacate the facility. First Aid facilities and "First Aid Officers" are available should you require attention.

SMOKING:

Smoking is not permitted within any Defence building, structure, vehicle or designated 'No Smoking' area.

VEHICLES AND EQUIPMENT

The maximum speed limit within HMAS CERBERUS is 40 KPH and is to be strictly adhered to at all times.

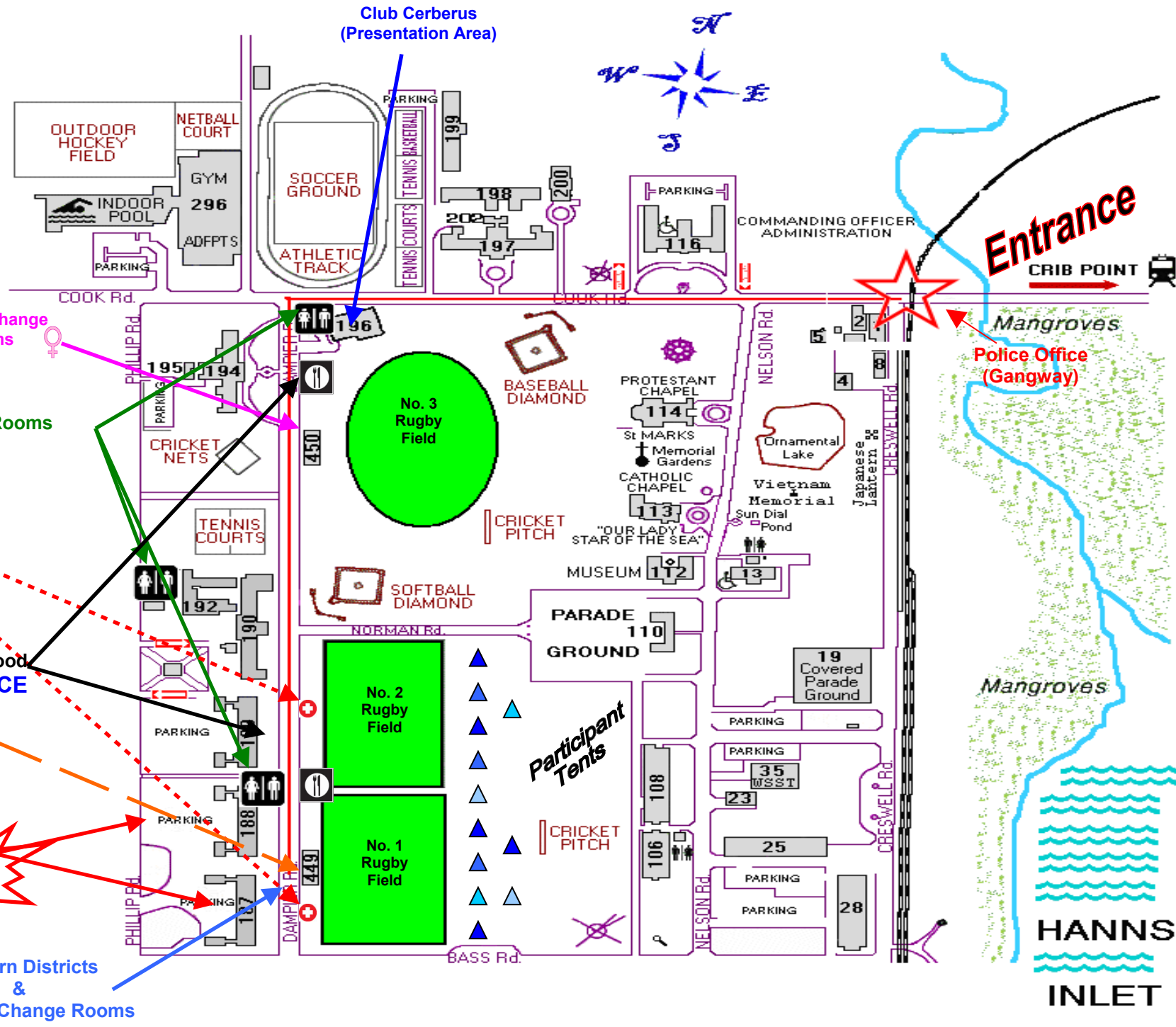
In addition visitors must:

- Give way to all formed squads, including marching, drilling and physical training personnel (formed squads may be overtaken at 20 KPH if safe to do so).
- No driving or parking on grassed areas unless prior approval is given.
- Give way to all mobile plant and equipment.
- No Private electrical/electronic equipment shall be used unless it has been approved.
- Only use cameras and audio visual equipment in the direct vicinity of the Churches, Museum, Graduation Parades and Divisions. Photography in other areas is strictly prohibited.
- Commonwealth vehicles and mobile plant shall not be used without prior written approval.

Visitors are not to go beyond the perimeter of the designated area
